
# RELIC OF ST. JUDE, APOSTLE AT ST. STEPHENS SEPTEMBER 14TH

O God, come to my assistance. O Lord, make haste to help me. Glory be to the Father.... Then pray one Our Father and three Hail Marys after each of the following:

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Seraphim** may the Lord make us worthy to burn with the fire of perfect charity. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Cherubim** may the Lord grant us the grace to leave the ways of sin and run in the paths of Christian perfection. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Thrones** may the Lord infuse into our hearts a true and sincere spirit of humility. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Dominions** may the Lord give us grace to govern our senses and overcome any unruly passions. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Powers** may the Lord protect our souls against the snares and temptations of the devil. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Virtues** may the Lord preserve us from evil and falling into temptation. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Principalities** may God fill our souls with a true spirit of obedience. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Archangels** may the Lord give us perseverance in faith and in all good works in order that we may attain the glory of Heaven. Amen

By the intercession of Saint Michael and the celestial Choir of **Angels** may the Lord grant us to be protected by them in this mortal life and conducted in the life to come to Heaven. Amen
