SCHOOL BUILDING AGREEMENT

St. Stephen Parish has entered into an agreement with Chesterton Academy of Bl. Pier Georgio Frassati to relocate the Chesterton Academy from its current location in Aquinas Hall at Holy Rosary Parish to St. Stephen's School building by the Fall of 2024. The relocation process will take several months and will involve working with the City of Portland to update the Conditional Use Permit for the school building. QUO VADIS DAYS: JUNE 26-29, 2023



Out of respect to Our Lord and for the edification of our neighbor, we beg all men, boys, women, and girls to appear in Church modestly dressed.

- No gym clothes, yoga clothes, revealing clothes or pajamas.
- No bare shoulders on men or women
- No cleavage, no bare chests. Ladies cover up. Men button up.
- No mini-skirts. Skirts should cover the knees while seated. Men should wear long pants.
- No anti-Christian clothing, logos, jewelry, make-up.
- Tattoos should be covered
- Remove piercings of tongues, lips, cheeks, eyelids, noses, or enlarged ears, etc.
- No Cross-dressing.
- No hair color that is unnatural (green, orange, blue, pink, etc.)
