

THE BLESSING OF HERBS ON THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY

Tuesday, August 15th. Please bring in a sampling of your garden harvest of fruits and vegetables for the annual blessing of herbs on the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Low Mass at 8 am. Sung Mass at 7 pm.

SAINT MICHAEL'S LENT - AUG 15 - SEPT 29

There are 40 days (not counting Sundays) from the Solemnity of the Assumption of the BVM to the Solemnity of St. Michael the Archangel. St. Francis of Assisi observed this 40 day period by fasting and prayer in observance of St. Michael's Fast or Lent. During this time, St. Francis experienced great graces and received the stigmata (the five nail wounds) of Christ. We too may receive great graces for fasting and praying during these 40 days. *A recommended penance* would be full abstinence from meat on Wednesdays and Fridays; partial abstinence (meat only at the main meal) every other day except Sunday. Optional: Fast and Abstinence on Wednesdays and Fridays. Pray the St. Michael Chaplet every day. Pray the Novena to St. Michael on the last nine days (Sept 20-28).


