The "O" Antiphons at Vespers

December 17:

O Wisdom that comest out of the mouth of the (Dost Nigh, that reachest from one end to another, and orderest all things mightily and sweetly, come to teach us the way of prudence!*

December 18:

O Adonai, and Ruler of the house of Israel, Who didst appear unto (Doses in the burning bush, and gavest him the law in Sinai, come to redeem us with an outstretched arm! *

December 19:

O Root of Jesse, which standest for an ensign of the people, at Whom the kings shall shut their mouths. Whom the Gentiles shall seek, come to deliver us, do not tarry.*

December 20:

O Key of David, and Sceptre of the house of Israel, that openeth and no man shutteth, and shutteth and no man openeth, come to liberate the prisoner from the prison, and them that sit in darkness, and in the shadow of death.*

December 21:

O Dayspring. Brightness of the everlasting light, Son of justice, come to give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death!*

December 22:

O King of the Gentiles, yea, and desire thereof! O Corner-stone, that makest of two one, come to save man, whom Ghou hast made out of the dust of the earth! *

December 23:

O Emmanuel, our King and our Law-giver, Longing of the Gentiles, yea, and salvation thereof, come to save us. O Lord our God! *

* Recite one Our Father, one Ŋail (Dary, and one Glory be each night after the antiphon.

Christmas Eve

Graditionally Christmas Eve is a fast day with full abstinence from meat. The festivity can be celebrated with a special seafood dinner: even lobster, crab or shellfish because it is so special among vigils. Plan a festive breakfast to celebrate right after (Didnight (Dass.)

In the five thousand one hundred and ninetyninth year of the creation of the world, from the time when God in the beginning created the beaven and earth; the two thousand nine bundred and fifty-seventh year after the Flood: the two thousand and fifteenth year from the birth of Abraham; the one thousand five hundred and tenth year from (Doses, and the going forth of the people of Israel from Egypt: the one thousand and thirty-second year from the anointing of David the King: in the sixty-fifth week according to the prophecy of Daniel: in the one hundred and ninetyfourth Olympiad, the seven hundred and fiftysecond year from the foundation of the city of Rome: the forty-second year of the rule of Octavianus Augustus, all the earth being at peace, in the sixth age of the history of the world, Jesus Christ, eternal God, and the Son of the Eternal Father, desiring to sanctify the world by his most merciful coming, being conceived by the Foly Ghost, and nine months having passed since his conception here the voice is raised and all kneel, is born as man, in Bethlehem of Judea, of the Virgin (Dary. The Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ according to the flesh."

Ghe Advent Wreath

One way to prepare for Christ's coming is to use an Advent Wreath at home. It is traditionally made of evergreen branches in a ring with purple ribbon and 4 candles inserted into it (3 purple and 1 rose candle each representing the four weeks of Advent). Each day the family should gather around the Advent wreath, generally before the evening meal. It starts at the evening meal on the Saturday before the first Sunday in Advent with the blessing of the wreath. (Ghe father of the family traditionally leads the prayers, and a different child may be chosen to light the candles each day). Additionally, a scripture passage from the day's Oass could be read and/or an Advent hymn could be sung.



Prayers: *

Father/parent: Our help is in the name of the Lord. All: Who made beaven and earth.

Father/parent: O God, by Whose word all things are sanctified, pour forth Ghy blessing upon this wreath and grant that we who use it may prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ and may receive from Ghee abundant graces. We ask this through Christ Our Lord.

All: Amen.

Ghe wreath is then sprinkled with holy water. Ghen follows the prayer which is said before the evening meal each night during that week. After the prayer, the candle or candles are lit.

Prayers for the Advent Wreath (continued)

1st Week of Advent: Ad te levávi Sunday

Father/parent: O Lord, we pray Thee, stir up Thy power, and come, that by Thy protection we may deserve to be rescued from the threatening dangers of our sins, and to be saved by Thy deliverance, Who livest, and reignest, forever and ever.

All: Amen.

Ghe candle is lit by the youngest child and allowed to burn during evening meals for the first week,

2nd Week of Advent: Populus Sion Sunday

Father/parent: Stir up our hearts, O Lord, to prepare the ways of Ghine Only-begotten Son, that we may attain to serve Ghee with purified minds, through η̄is advent. Who with Ghee in the unity of the η̄oly Ghost, livest and reignest, forever and ever.

All: Amen.

After the prayer, the oldest child lights the first and second purple candles.

3rd Week of Advent: Gaudete Sunday

Father/parent: Incline Thine ear to our prayers, we beseech Thee, O Lord, and brighten the darkness of our minds by the grace of Thy visitation. Who livest and reignest, forever and ever.

All: Amen.

Ghe mother lights the pink, as well as the two previously burned purple candles

4th Week of Advent: Rorate Caeli Sunday

Father/parent: Stir up, we beseech Ghee, O Lord, Ghy power, and come, and succor us with great might, that, by the help of Ghy grace, that which our sins do hinder, may be hastened by the bounty of Ghy mercy. Who livest and reignest, forever and ever.

All: Amen.

All four candles are lit by the father of the family and allowed to burn during the evening meals of the fourth week.

During Christmas, the candles are changed to white.

Ghe Christmas Novena 16th - 24th of any month

+++Prayer entirely each day+++

- 1. Eternal Father, I offer to Ghine honor and glory, for my eternal salvation and for the salvation of the whole world, the mystery of the birth of our divine Redeemer. Glory be ...
- 2. Eternal Father, I offer to Ghine honor and glory, for my eternal salvation and for the salvation of the whole world, the sufferings of the most holy Virgin and Saint Joseph on that long and weary journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem, and the anguish of their hearts at not finding a place of shelter when the Saviour of the world was about to be born. Glory be ...
- 3. Eternal Father, I offer to Thine honor and glory, for my eternal salvation and for the salvation of the whole world, the sufferings of Jesus in the manger where Ne was born, the cold Ne suffered, the tears Ne shed and Nis tender infant cries. Glory be ...
- 4. Eternal Father, I offer to Thine honor and glory, for my eternal salvation and for the salvation of the whole world, the pain which the divine Child Jesus felt in Tis tender Body, when Tie submitted to the rite of circumcision: I offer Thee that Precious Blood which Tie then first shed for the salvation of all mankind. Glory be ...
- 5. Eternal Father, I offer to Thine honor and glory, for my eternal salvation and for the salvation of the whole world, the humility, mortification, patience, charity and all the virtues of the Child Jesus: I thank Thee, I love Thee, and I bless Thee infinitely for this ineffable mystery of the Incarnation of the Word of God, Glory be...

V. The Word was made flesh: (genuflect) R. And dwelt amongst us.

Let us pray. (stand)

O God, Whose only-begotten Son hath appeared in the substance of our flesh: grant, we beseech Ghee, that through Ŋim, whom we acknowledge to have been outwardly like unto us, we may deserve to be renewed in our inward selves. Who liveth and reigneth with Ghee for ever and ever. Amen.
