Saturday, **October 21st** is the feast day of His Imperial and Apostolic Majesty, Blessed Karl Von Habsburg (+1922). October 21st is the date of his marriage to Servant of God Zita of Bourbon-Parma. Bl. Karl is known as the Emperor of Peace for his cooperation with the Peace Plan of Pope Benedict XV, and his efforts to end the First World War. Let us call upon his intercession today for peace in our troubled world. A Novena is being prayed from October 12th - 20th in preparation for his feast day but may also be prayed at any time. 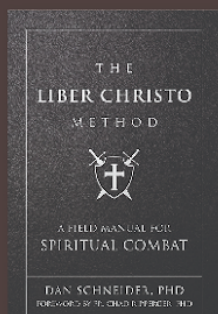
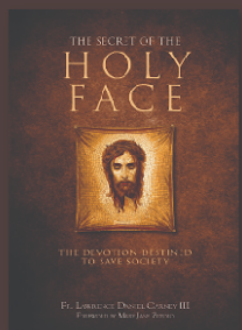
