

BURYING OF THE ALLELUIA. SATURDAY, JANUARY 27TH

5 pm. First Vespers of Septuagesima concludes with a solemn "Benedicamus Domino, alleluia, alleluia". The 'alleluia' will not be heard again until the Easter Vigil on March 30th. The very word "alleluia" will be buried at the Saint Joseph Altar, as a sign of mourning. Please join us to bid a mournful fareful to this blessed word as we enter into the Pre-Lenten season.

CANDLEMAS - THE PURIFICATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN

Friday, February 2nd. The 40th day after the Nativity of the Lord is marked by the blessing and procession of small candles in honor of the Presentation of the Child Jesus. The blessed tapers are sacramentals for the faithful to take home. You may bring candles to be blessed, but let them be of beeswax, or partially of beeswax. Regular household candles will not be blessed. This is the last of the feasts of the Christmas cycle. Vespers on this day will conclude with the singing of the *Alma Redemptoris Mater*. At Compline, the singing of the *Ave Regina Caelorum* will commence and last through Septuagesima and Lent. Low Mass at 12 Noon. High Mass at 7 pm.

BLESSING OF THROATS ON THE FEAST OF ST. BLAISE

Saturday morning, Feb 3rd following the 9 am Mass. The priest, holding two candles crossed and tied together with a red ribbon, will come to the communion rail and, holding the candles under each person's throat, shall say: "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

SEVEN SUNDAYS OF ST. JOSEPH: FEBRUARY 4th - MARCH 17th

2 pm each Sunday in the church. A special devotion to St. Joseph may be prayed for 7 Sundays prior to his feast on March 19th. The devotion consists of praying the Seven Sorrows and Joys of St. Joseph, one mystery each Sunday over seven weeks.
