LESSER LITANIES/ROGATION DAYS - MAY 23-25

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday May 23-25th: The three days prior to Ascension Thursday are a Triduum of their own preparing for the departure of the Lord. On these days, penitential litanies are prayed in procession with the Crucifix lifted high in the air, followed by Rogation Masses. Each day begins with Sung Vespers at 5 pm. The procession follows Vespers at approximately 5:30. Mass follows at approximately 6:15 or 6:30 pm. There will be no Confessions on Wednesday. Come when you can.
